

April was a good month for Heritage. You have continued to be faithful givers and our trustees and staff have been good stewards working to reduce expenses. Please continue to give online or by mail so that we can continue our mission. While we are out of the building, finance has given the trustees the go ahead to complete an improvement project to the chancel area in the sanctuary. Two families have pledged \$1000 each towards the start of a \$10,000 challenge to raise funds for the church to purchase our own video equipment. This will allow us to continue our online recordings and grow them into other ministry areas as well as the ability to do live streaming. At this time all in person activities are cancelled as required by Emergency Order. We continue to offer worship and children's ministry online and our small groups, bible studies and youth have been meeting via Zoom.

The church office will officially remain closed through May 31 and staff will continue to work from home.

Messages and mail will be checked on a regular basis.

Pastor Maria, the leadership team and staff are closely following the State, County and Conference requirements to put a plan in place that will allow us to safely reopen. At this time we are looking at mid-June as our soft opening for worship. This will require us to follow social distancing rules and group limits in our building. Many things will be different and we do not anticipate having nursery or children's events in place until the fall due to social distancing requirements.

We are still trying to figure out how this will look to keep everyone safe. One thing we will be doing shortly is sending out a survey to see how you all feel about returning to help us determine numbers for seating plans. As plans are realized we will communicate them to you via the Friday e-note.

General Conference 2020 Update

After the pandemic-caused postponement, the new prospective dates for the UMC's General Conference are Aug. 31-Sept. 10, 2021. The Council of Bishops disclosed the proposed dates, including a Council of Bishops meeting starting Aug. 26, in an email to its members and other church leaders. General Conference organizers have not confirmed the dates. General Conference was originally scheduled to meet at the convention center May 5-15 of this year. With the legislative assembly on the calendar, other church gatherings also will get new dates.

The Council of Bishops <u>said that once the General Conference dates are official</u>, new dates will be announced for the five jurisdictional conferences—simultaneous meetings where new U.S. bishops are elected. The jurisdictional conferences, originally scheduled for July, are now on hold. The yearlong postponement of General Conference is unprecedented, according to the United Methodist Commission on Archives and History.

The gathering — the only body that officially speaks for the entire United Methodist Church — is responsible for many crucial decisions. These include electing members of the Judicial Council, the denomination's equivalent of the Supreme Court, and voting on the four-year budget that funds denomination-wide ministries. Among other factors, the budget affects how many bishops the denomination will financially support and thus how many can be elected.

The 2020 gathering also was set to consider multiple proposals to split the denomination and divide assets after longtime debate over biblical interpretation and the status of LGBTQ people. Those proposals are now on hold.
