

Heritage UMC Safety Protocols for Worship

- Service is at 9:30am - reservations are **not** required.
- Masks are required for those ages 4 and up.
- Hand-sanitizer is available at each entrance.
- Please enter through the Main Entrance Fellowship Hall doors. The North side doors will be open to those in need of a handicap entrance.
- Ushers will be available to greet you and provide additional direction and assist in seating, as needed.
- Families are encouraged to sit together and leave 2 empty seats between other individuals/family groups.
- Everyone is encouraged to sing and join in prayers and responses while wearing their masks.
- Offering baskets are available, but will not be passed during service.
- Online giving is now easier than ever using our secure *Text to Give* feature. Simply text an amount to 844-610-0379.
- Prepackaged communion elements will be provided on communion Sundays.
- Drinks are allowed in the sanctuary, but no food.
- Everyone is encouraged to engage in outdoor fellowship before and/or after service in the courtyard area or parking lot.
- Children's Sunday School will continue to meet via Zoom through the end of May.
- There is no nursery offered at this time.

Please remember, do not attend in-person, and join us for online worship, if you:

- Don't feel well, or have had symptoms such as a cough, fever, sore throat, or shortness of breath within the past 10 days;
- Have tested positive for COVID or been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID in the past 10 days; or
- Have traveled to an area or event on the KDHE mandatory quarantine list.
